This notice also serves as your TEMPORARY DRIVER'S LICENSE, which expires 7 days from the Effective Date of Notice, or upon the expiry of your license, whichever is earlier. If you hold a valid driver's license issued outside Nova Scotia, your right to operate a motor vehicle in Nova Scotia and your privilege of obtaining a Nova Scotia driver's license are suspended for a period of 3 months, effective 7 days from the Effective Date of Notice. Suspended □ Revoked If you do not hold a valid driver's license (because your license has been suspended or revoked, or you are unlicensed), then your right to operate a motor vehicle in Nova Scotia and your privilege of obtaining a driver's license are immediately suspended and continue to be suspended for a period of 3 months from the Effective Date of Notice.
